SUBMISSION OF CURRENT LIST OF ALL MAINTENANCE ENGINEERS

AND COPY OF EXPATRIATE QUOTA.

In line with the Federal Government human resources policy objectives and sequel to the Authority's All Operators Letters with Circular ref: NCAA/DAWS/AD.1104/AOL 046 and 047, all aircraft owners/operators and AMOs in Nigeria are hereby required to submit to the

1. Current list of all maintenance engineers both nationals and foreigners with their qualifications and training; and

2. A copy of the expatriate quota granted by the Citizenship & Business Department of the Federal Ministry of Interior to their organisation from the year 2006 to 2013.

Submission of the above documents is in addition to the documents earlier required by the above referenced All Operators Letters 046 and 047.

Any aircraft owner/operator and AMOs that has been complying with the expatriate quota may show proof of two (2) nationals that have been trained up to the skill level of each expatriate on the expatriate quota list.

All the required documents are to be submitted on or before 24th February, 2014.
