SUPPLY SERVICES TO AIRLINES AT AIRPORTS IN NIGERIA

This is to notify you that the Authority is in receipt of satisfactory letter from the Department of Petroleum Resources (DPR) that the under listed companies can now engage in aviation fuel distributions at the airport. Inspections of the aviation fuel facilities and equipment of the companies was found satisfactory by the Authority.

The Authority has therefore lifted the suspension placed on the under listed aviation fueling companies:

- Lubcon Limited
- 2. Ascon Oil Company Limited
- 3. Acorn Petroleum Plc.

The Authority has required the Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FAAN) to grant access into airports in Nigeria to the above listed companies' aviation fueling vehicles and personnel.
