SUBJECT: IMPORTANT REMINDER ON THE PROVISION OF SAFETY INSPECTION SERVICES BY THE AUTHORITY TO ALL AIRCRAFT OPERATORS

You will recall that the Authority issued an All Operators Letter (AOL) Ref: NCAA/FSG/AOL/15/001 dated 7th September, 2015 to inform all aircraft operators of the need to make payments for safety inspection services at least **Fourteen (14) working days** before the intended date of the inspection. The **Fourteen (14) working days** specified is to enable the Authority to carry out the required internal processes with regards to the travel arrangements as stated in relevant extant Federal Government guidelines.

This AOL is to seriously remind all aircraft operators that the Authority is determined to enforce this directive on the request for provision of safety inspection services by operators with a view to serve the operators better and to ensure the Authority provides efficient safety oversight services in line with our mission while complying with relevant Federal Government guidelines.

This is for your reminder and continuing compliance.
