Subject: NIG. CARS REGULATION 9.1.1.8(a) (3)

The Authority has discovered that some Air Operators Certificate (AOC) holders who have suspended operations for more than sixty (60) days have refused to surrender the certificate to the Authority.

The Nigeria Civil Aviation Regulation (Nig. CARs) regulation 9.1.1.8(a)(3) states as follows " *An AOC, or any portion of the AOC, issued by the Authority is effective for a period not to exceed twenty-four months from the date of issue unless the AOC holder suspends operations for more than 60 days.*

Henceforth, any Air Operators Certificate holder who suspends operation for more than sixty (60) days should surrender that certificate to the Authority and any non-compliance with this requirement may lead to eventual revocation of the certificate.

Your strict compliance with this requirement is mandatory.
